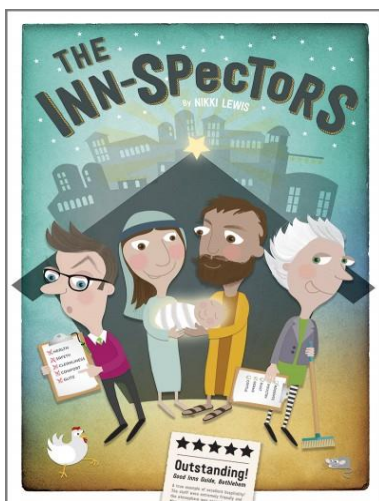
Pantomime - Beauty and the Beast Tuesday 3 December
