

SHADOW PUPPET WORKSHOP for KS2

Wednesday 19th November



As part of the KS2 '**Let there be Light**' topic the children have been learning about light and shadows. We have organised for an interactive shadow puppet workshop provided by Dark Star puppets on the 17th November.

Materials needed:

One cardboard box - cereal size/amazon book size – per child

Paper Fasteners

Plastic Carton (only one per child)

Garden sticks - ones for supporting plants and as many as possible

Coloured plastic - light plastic bags or cellophane

The school will provide some pencils, scissors, glue, sellotape, masking tape, drawing pins, cellophane and some paper fasteners but it would be really helpful if children bring in some or all of the items listed and of course it would be great if they can bring extra items to share.

During the workshop the children will use a story to spark their creative imagination and utilise the materials they have brought to share, to make a shadow puppet. The Dark Star Puppet workshop leader will provide guidance and ideas to help create the characters in the story and children will take home a puppet made of recycled imagination! **At the end of the day the children will share their shadow puppet story with the younger children in school.**
