Update on School

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to update you further on the latest information regarding school moving forward for the rest of this term. Our plan is outlined below but please be aware this may change as things evolve.

School to remain open for key worker and vulnerable children

I am fully aware that during the first lockdown that school remained closed to all children. However, after discussions with staff I am happy to inform you that we intend whenever possible to remain open to all our vulnerable and key worker children.

Changes to school start and finish time

Unfortunately, we have had to review the school start and end times.

Starting from tomorrow Wednesday 6th January school will start at 8:45am and finish at the earlier time of 3:00pm for all children. Due to the numbers in school children will be having a shorter lunchtime and staff have agreed undertake extra cleaning duties and extra planning to support on line learning. I apologise if this cause any problems but we are working in unusual times.

Face masks.

We are kindly asking all parents to wear face masks when dropping off and collecting your children to help further reduce the spread of infection.

Home Learning

It is very important that all children that are working at home follow the daily timetable set out by the class teachers as closely as possible. The teachers will also be contacting you and the children via Class DoJo during the day. We are also able to produce packs of work that can be collected from school to support with this. Please let the class teacher know if you need these.

Staff will respond to any messages as soon as possible but please understand they may be teaching in school at the time you message so you may get a delay in their response.
