Covid-19 Update on School

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to update you further on the latest information regarding school moving forward for the rest of this term. Our plan is outlined below but please be aware this may change as things evolve.

Children in Separate classes

The return of all children has seen them settle well as they continue their learning journey with us. For the safety of all we and to minimise the risk of infection we are continuing to operate in two separate classes with the children being kept apart. Please remember if your child displays any of the symptoms they should not be in school until they have been tested. If we have to close one of the classes, we will move back to home learning for that class along with any siblings in the other class.

Social Distance and Face masks.

We are kindly asking all parents to wear face masks when dropping off and collecting your children to help further reduce the spread of infection. Also please can you adhere to social distancing rules or even better remain in your cars until the school doors are open. I appreciate this may appear to be drastic measures but we all need to help protect our school community by doing as much as we can to reduce the risk of spreading any infection.

School day

The doors will continue to open at 8:45am for drop off and 3:15 for pick up for all children. This is again to minimise risk by not having families waiting for siblings who finish at a different time of day. Please let me know if this causes you any problems.

Staff will continue to communicate with you using class DoJo they will respond to any messages as soon as possible but please understand they may be teaching in school at the time you message so you may get a delay in their response.
