KS2 - 4 year topic cycle

Each year there are three or four themes with a science, geography and/or history focus. Children are consulted so we can reflect and build upon their interests as much as possible. There is a strong emphasis on the creative arts and art/design, music and DT are taught through the topics. English sessions are linked to the topics covered, using quality fiction, non-fiction texts. Maths, MFL, RE and PE are taught as discrete subjects with links when applicable. Computing is linked to the topics and ICT skills are then used throughout the curriculum. Science is taught as topics on a two year rolling programme so that all children cover each area in both lower and upper KS2, building on their previous learning.
