Dear Parent and Carers,

Happy New Year to all our families - where did the first half of January go! Welcome back to 2023 - the children have impressed us with their enthusiasm and resilience and have come back to school showing they are ready to learn.

Woodpeckers have started their new topic 'Home Sweet Home' and EYFS have started their new topic 'My Home, Your Home'. Last week, Woodpeckers started their wider opportunities singing project and are already in fine voice practising a range of new songs.

Peregrines have been learning about persuasion and have been designing their own toy and persuaded others to buy it. This term is the year 3/4 forest schools and they have already got off to a wet, muddy start enjoying the school's outdoor environment.

Kingfishers have worked hard in Mr Cooke's absence and will have lots tell him all about electricity, how to persuade, The New Testament, ratio and proportion and drawing maps. The topic for Peregrines and Kingfishers this term is 'Location, Location'.

### WIDER OPPORTUNITIES MUSIC

Woodpeckers have now started their singing project. This is a 10 week programme and there will be a performance to parents on Tuesday  $21^{st}$  March.

### Maths

Year 6 children are currently working on ratio and proportion.

Y3/4 and 5 are all working on their multiplication skills.

In Woodpeckers, the children are learning about understanding number bonds and subtraction.
There are lots of activities on Education City to support your child with their maths learning. For children in key stage 2, please keep practising times tables (year 4 will have their times tables test in June, which is set by the DFE).

## Reading

We have continued to review and update reading in school. The library area has been completely sorted out and books made more easily accessible for the children.

Woodpecker's books have also been reorganised to give children more choice when choosing books to practise their phonics. Reading for pleasure books are now easier for the children to look through.

We have also started buddy reading. This term, Kingfisher class and Woodpecker class are working together.

Please support your child by listening to them read regularly and writing a short, positive comment in their reading record.

# Keeping Safe in School

Keeping children safe in school continues to be our priority. Our Values for Life theme for this term is Peace. We have been focussing on friendship and solving conflicts and who our trusted adults are if we feel uncomfortable - particularly in a friendship situation. At the end of last term, children took part in assemblies run by the NSPCC and the year 5 / 6 children had a workshop about speaking out. In PSHCE, we are learning about relationships and what makes a healthy relationship.
