Here are your learning tasks for today:

SNOW PLAY

Maths - Education City

Literacy



Friday is always our spelling test day in school. Ask an adult to test your spellings - don't forget to have a final practise to make sure you know them well.

Find a great book and read for at least **10 minutes**. Try and share your reading with an adult and talk about what you have learnt about the story or piece of non-fiction.

Have a go at writing a snowy poem. You could try an acrostic - a line for each letter of the word **SNOW**. Challenge yourself to use a longer snowy word - Freezing, snowflake, sledging.

Create a piece of 'snowy art'. This could be a picture or painting from your window, some snowy photography or even a snow sculpture.
