#### Things to remember for the start of term

### PE / Forest Schools / Swimming

Please make sure you are wearing a school PE kit for PE (red tee-shirt (available with logo), black or blue shorts, white socks, trainers. For the colder weather, black or blue joggers or tracksuit and a red, blue or black top. Earrings are not allowed on PE or swimming days.

For forest schools, children can wear their own clothes. Clothes must be suitable for outdoor (often wet and muddy) activities. They will need to bring a coat and wellies (or change of shoes)

For Swimming, children come in their costume under their school uniform. Remember to bring underwear for changing as well as a towel / goggles.
