Early Help for families

At Stretton Handley CE (VC) Primary School, we are committed to supporting all of our families. The school Pastoral care is managed by Mrs Nicholson who provides children and parents with pastoral support. Mrs Nicholson works closely with Gemma Steeples from the Derbyshire Help team, and together, they are able to support with:

- Issues surrounding attendance,
- Support with TAF (Team around the family) meetings. These are voluntary meetings led by school and involve support families with multi agencies.
- Support parents/carers with behaviour at home.
- Provide pupils in school with 1:1 and group pastoral interventions.
- Provide tailored support for pupils with Special Educational Needs.

- Plan and deliver active provision at lunchtime for all pupils across the school.

What support is available for families during school holidays?
