Tudor people

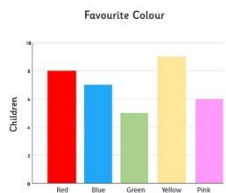
Find out about a significant person who lived during the Tudor period (1485 to 1603). It could be a monarch, explorer or writer. Create a fact file so you can tell us all about them.

Quiz your family or bring them into school for us to guess.



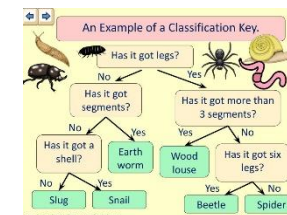
Stop Food Waste.
