Find 5 facts about Viking or Saxon life and then write these using runes

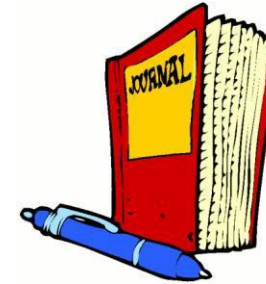
'Hoo' are you? Make your own version of the Mask/helmet found at Sutton Hoo and a label to explain what you know about it.



Make a comic strip version of an Anglo Saxon or Viking based story eg Erik The Viking, Thor's hammer, Beowolf



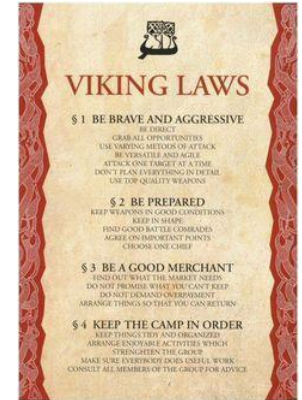
☺ **Write a diary** for your Viking raiding quest. (Approx 1 side of A4 or more)



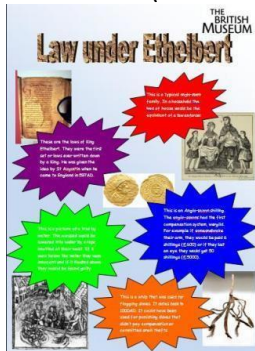
Remember checklist of diary features:

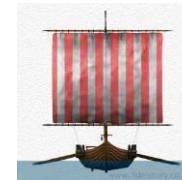
Design your own (realistic!) Anglo Saxon coin.

(Y5Y6 – Divide the sale into four and make sure your design has rotational symmetry too)

The Vikings used bows and arrows to hunt and in battle. Make a target game and record the totals you score. (Use bean bags or balls instead of arrows!!)

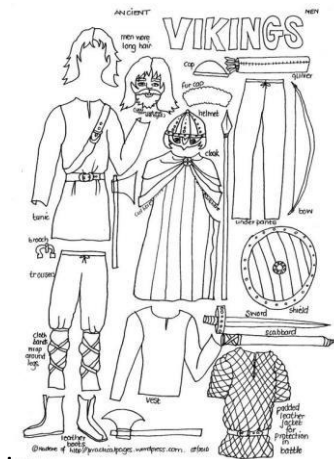


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Make a **Viking collage** of a viking boat on the sea using coloured paper from magazines, fabric , etc.



Make a 'paperdoll' type Viking figure with clothes . Remember the flaps so you can dress the figure! You could do a warrior and a farmer figure.



Holiday destination

Choose one of the countries that the Vikings were from (Denmark, Norway, and Sweden). Find out what the country is like **now** and make a poster (A3) or ppt presentation to tell people all about it. (*Location, weather, landmarks, flag etc*) (About 10 slides)



☺ Make an information booklet about Viking gods and goddesses. (At least four)



☺ Draw yourself and a Viking child. Label the differences between your life and their life. (Include information on school, toys, homes, pets, work).
